

## **CODE OF CONDUCT FOR MINI-RUGBY CLUB MEMBERS FAIR PLAY POLICY WITHIN ENNISKILLEN RUGBY FOOTBALL CLUB**

- Players play for enjoyment and to improve skills, not just to please their parents or coach.
- Where rules apply, players must try to understand and abide by them.
- Players must accept the decisions of coaches and officials.
- Players must control their tempers at all times.
- Players will be “Good Sports”. They will show appreciation for good play on either side.
- The aim of the game is to have fun and improve skills.
- Players will work equally hard for themselves AND the team.
- Players will treat others as they themselves would like to be treated. They will not bully or take unfair advantage of any player.
- Players will co-operate with the coach, team-mates and opponents – without them there is no game.
- Always behave in a manner that avoids bringing the game of rugby and Enniskillen RFC into disrepute.
- Always behave and obey coaches on transport both to and from away fixtures. Refrain from the use of bad language and inappropriate gestures.
- Win with grace and lose with dignity. Respect opponents and always shake hands at the end of a game!
